Position Description:

The Palos Verdes / South Bay Audubon Society is seeking a dedicated Project Manager to steer the development and oversight of ad hoc and multi-year projects. The Project Manager will work directly for the Society's Board to manage on-going projects and develop new projects that will benefit local birds and other wildlife species.

Key Responsibilities:

- > Establishing clear objectives and milestones for each project;
- > Partner and collaborate with local organizations and agencies;
- Oversee financial aspects of projects;
- Prepare progress and final reports to ensure all stakeholders are well informed; and
- > Engage in grant writing and management to secure necessary funding.

Qualifications:

- Degree or equivalent in biological or environmental sciences.
- Familiarity with the local fauna and flora, especially the Coastal Sage Scrub habitat found on the Palos Verdes Peninsula; and
- Knowledge of the Palos Verdes Peninsula birds is desired,
- Proficiency in
 - Independent work management
 - Engaging with the public, volunteers, governmental bodies, and city councils
 - Conducting public outreach activities
- > Strong communication skills across multiple media types, including verbal, written, and electronic.

- > Project Manager works under the direction of the Board of Directors.
- Pay is competitive and commensurate with experience \$25-30/hr.
- > This part-time (20 hrs/week) role offers flexible working hours.
- > Opportunity for additional hours contingent upon successful grant acquisitions.
